

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Ibabao-Estancia, Mandaue City as of 10 March 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 07 March 2025 at around 7:20 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Ibabao-Estancia, Mandaue City. The fire was declared out at around 8:23 PM.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office in Region VII, actively participated in the response operation and maintains continuous coordination with the Local Government Unit of Mandaue City to manage the needs of displaced families and individuals, provide timely updates, and address potential requests for relief augmentation.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **89 families** or **317 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Ibabao-Estancia, Mandaue City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **89 families** or **317 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Brgy. Ibabao Gymnasium** in **Brgy. Ibabao-Estancia, Mandaue City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **54 houses** were damaged; of which, **52** are **totally damaged** and **two (2)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Ibabao-Estancia, Mandaue City** (see Annex C).
