

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Lahug, Cebu City as of 02 March 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 27 February 2025 at around 6:59 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Lahug, Cebu City, and it was declared fire out at around 9:41 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **88 families** or **344 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Lahug, Cebu City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **52 families** or **152 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at **Lahug Elementary School Gymnasium** in **Brgy. Lahug, Cebu City** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **36 families** or **192 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **88 families** or **344 persons** still displaced in **Brgy. Lahug, Cebu City** (see Annex E).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **57 houses** were damaged; of which, **52** are **totally damaged** and **five (5)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Lahug, Cebu City** (see Annex F).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱281,600.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** to the affected families (see Annex G).
