I. Situation Overview

On 05 March 2025 at around 4:44 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 16, Carson St., Brgy. Lubogan, Davao City. The fire was declared out at around 6:50 PM.

A total of 121 families or 258 persons are affected in Brgy. Lubogan, Davao City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 121 families or 258 persons currently taking temporary shelter in Uda Gym Evacuation Center in Brgy. Lubogan, Davao City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 119 houses were damaged; of which, 117 are totally damaged and two (2) are partially damaged in Brgy. Lubogan, Davao City (see Annex E)..
