I. Situation Overview

On 03 March 2025 at around 2:58 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Mantuyong, Mandaue City. The fire was declared out at around 4:42 PM.

A total of **120 families** or **585 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Mantuyong, Mandaue City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 120 families or 585 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Gymnasium in Brgy. Mantuyong, Mandaue City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 82 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Mantuyong, Mandaue City (see Annex C).
