

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Paknaan, Mandaue City as of 26 March 2025, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 23 March 2025 at around 7:34 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Paknaan, Mandaue City. The fire was declared out at around 10:32 PM.

A total of **256 families** or **919 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Paknaan, Mandaue City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **256 families** or **919 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in a **Gymnasium** in **Brgy. Paknaan, Mandaue City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **199 houses** were damaged; of which, **194** are **totally damaged** and **five (5)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Paknaan, Mandaue City** (see Annex C).
