

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Flash Flood Incidents in Libungan, North Cotabato

as of 07 March 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 March 2025 at around 4:00 AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms due to Easterlies may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms.

On the same day at around 3:00 PM, several barangays in Libungan, North Cotabato experienced flash floods due to heavy rains caused by Easterlies.

A total of **887 families** or **2,763 persons** are affected in **seven (7) barangays** in **Libungan, North Cotabato** (see Annex A).
