

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Flooding Incidents in Mindanao as of 19 May 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 15 May 2025 at 4:00 AM, cloudy skies with scattered rain and thunderstorms caused by the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) may have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains in Mindanao, Eastern Visayas, and Palawan.

On the same day, a flooding incident was experienced in Brgy. Nangaon, Opol, Misamis Oriental, due to continuous heavy rains brought about by the prevailing ITCZ.

Meanwhile, families who had undertaken pre-emptive evacuation due to heavy rains in the province of Lanao del Norte have already returned to their respective homes.

On 18 May 2025 at 1:00 AM, continuous rainfall brought by the ITCZ also caused flooding in Brgy. Baluntay, Alabel, Sarangani.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **315 families** or **1,742 persons** are affected in **Mindanao** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **200 families** or **1,167 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **200 houses** were damaged; of which, **33** are **totally damaged** and **167** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Nangaon, Opol, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex C).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱24.84 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱6 million available at DSWD FOs X and XII.
- ₱42 million available in other FOs, which may support the relief needs of the families affected by the flooding incidents through inter-FO augmentation.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 793,534 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 409,973 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 383,561 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 224,101 FFPs available at DSWD FOs X and XII.
- 1,983,290 FFPs are available in other FOs, which may support the relief needs of the families affected by the flooding incidents through inter-FO augmentation.
- ₱865.30 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FOs X and XII warehouses.
