

DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Effects of Northeast Monsoon in Northern Luzon as of 05 March 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

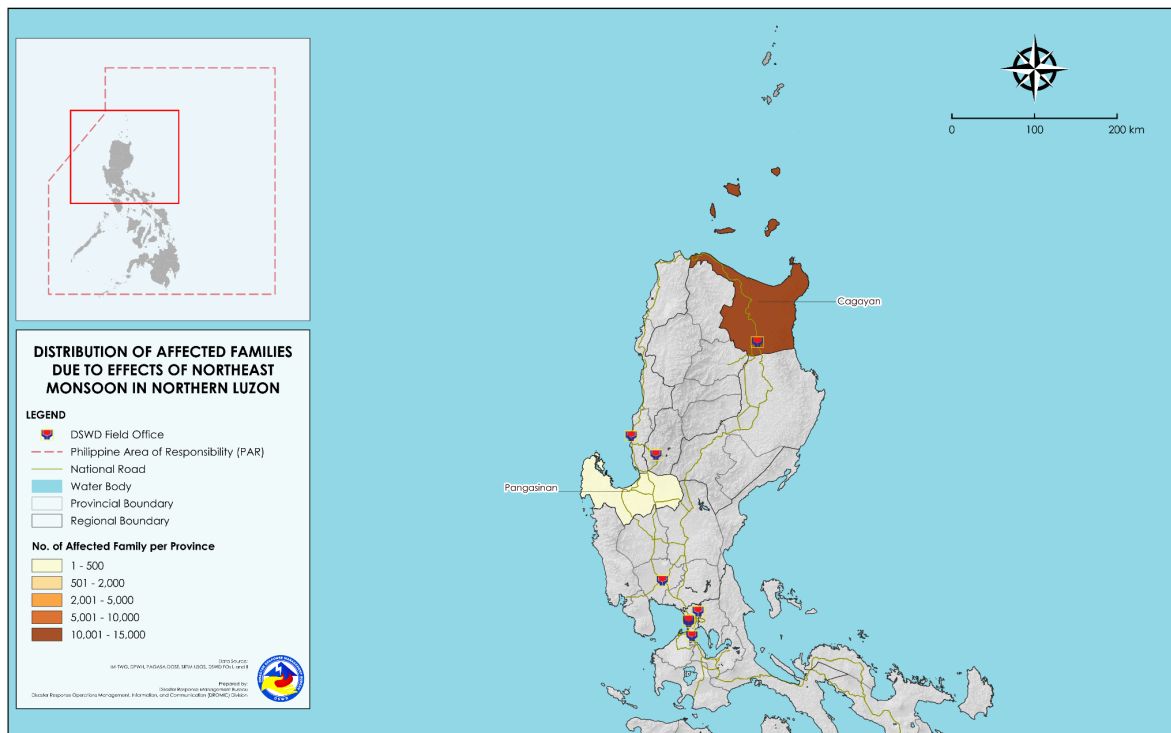
On 06 February 2025, cloudy skies with rains due to Northeast Monsoon may have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains over Cagayan Valley, Cordillera Administrative Region, Ilocos Norte, and Aurora. On the same day, several municipalities in Cagayan Valley experienced flooding due to the Northeast Monsoon.

On 08 February 2025 at around 4:00 PM, a strong wind incident due to the Northeast Monsoon was experienced in Brgy. Toboy, Asingan, Pangasinan.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **10,229 families** or **34,056 persons** are affected in **37 barangays** in **Regions I and II** (see Annex A).



III. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Region I (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱9,548,997.59** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family composed of **₱9,538,397.59** from **DSWD** and **₱10,600.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex C).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱3.30 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱6 million available at DSWD FOs I and II.
- ₱36.44 million available in other DSWD FOs which may support the relief needs of the affected families.

- 512,234 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 197,994 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 314,240 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 174,986 FFPs available at DSWD FOs I and II.
- 1,798,621 FFPs available in other DSWD FOs which may support the relief needs of the affected families.
