

DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 602, Sta. Mesa, Manila City as of 20 March 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 March 2025 at around 10:48 AM, a fire incident occurred at V. Mapa Extension corner Pat Antonio St., Brgy. 602, Sta. Mesa, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 2:40 PM. Due to the incident, 747 individuals were affected resulting in total damages of 40 houses.

In response to the incident, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office National Capital Region (FO NCR), in close coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Manila City, provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

A total of **224 families** or **747 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 602, Sta. Mesa, Manila City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **224 families** or **747 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. 602 Barangay Hall** in **Sta. Mesa, Manila City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **40 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 602, Sta. Mesa, Manila City** (see Annex B).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱557,312.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
