

DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Lubogan, Davao City as of 11 March 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 05 March 2025 at around 4:44 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 16, Carson St., Brgy. Lubogan, Davao City. The fire was declared out at around 6:50 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **121 families** or **258 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Lubogan, Davao City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **121 families** or **258 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Uda Gym Evacuation Center** in **Brgy. Lubogan, Davao City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **119 houses** were damaged; of which, **117** are **totally damaged** and **two (2)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Lubogan, Davao City** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱967,367.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
