

# DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Mambaling, Cebu City

as of 09 March 2025, 6AM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 02 March 2025 at around 1:18 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Mambaling, Cebu City. The fire was declared out at around 3:05 AM.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **182 families** or **1,076 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Mambaling, Cebu City** (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **168 families** or **686 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Viking Gym** in **Brgy. Mambaling, Cebu City** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **14 families** or **390 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

There are 182 families or 1,076 persons still displaced in Brgy. Mambaling, Cebu City (see Annex E).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 143 houses were damaged; of which, 142 are totally damaged and one (1) is partially damaged in Brgy. Mambaling, Cebu City (see Annex F).

#### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}3,092,650.98\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of which, \$\mathbb{P}580,650.98\$ from \$\mathbb{D}SWD\$ and \$\mathbb{P}2,512,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex G).
