

DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Paknaan, Mandaue City as of 26 March 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 23 March 2025 at around 7:34 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Paknaan, Mandaue City. The fire was declared out at around 10:32 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **269 families** or **1,003 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Paknaan, Mandaue City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **269 families** or **1,003 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in a **Gymnasium** in **Brgy. Paknaan, Mandaue City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **188 houses** were damaged; of which, **179** are **totally damaged** and **nine (9)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Paknaan, Mandaue City** (see Annex C).
