

## DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Flash Flood Incidents in Mindanao as of 10 March 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

Issued on 03 March 2025 at around 4:00 PM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms due to Easterlies may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms in Mindanao.

On 03 March 2025, at around 3:30 PM, several barangays in Pandag, Maguindanao del Sur experienced flash floods due to heavy rains caused by Easterlies.

On 04 March 2025 at around 3:00 PM, several barangays in Libungan, North Cotabato experienced flash floods due to heavy rains caused by Easterlies.

A total of **7,232 families** or **21,798 persons** are affected in **14 barangays** in **Region XII** and **BARMM** (see Annex A).
