

## DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Effects of Easterlies in Davao Region as of 26 March 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

Issued on 17 March 2025 at 4:00 AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms were observed, attributed to the Easterlies. These conditions may have led to possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains affecting the Davao Region.

On the same day, continuous rainfall due to Easterlies caused flooding and landslides in the municipalities of Mabini, Davao de Oro and Malita, Davao Occidental.

In response to the incident, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) XI, promptly coordinated with the affected Local Government Units (LGUs) to gather significant updates and assess the need for resource augmentation to support the immediate relief efforts for the affected families.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **5,007 families** or **19,189 persons** are affected in **nine (9) barangays** in **Davao Region** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **52 families** or **133 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **15 houses** were damaged; of which, **10 are totally damaged** and **five (5) are partially damaged** in **Brgy. Napnapan, Pantukan, Davao de Oro** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱6,803,926.92** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
