

# DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Lahug, Cebu City

as of 07 March 2025, 6AM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 27 February 2025 at around 6:59 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Lahug, Cebu City. The fire was declared fire out at 9:41 PM.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **82 families** or **323 persons** are affected in **Brgy**. **Lahug**, **Cebu City** (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 52 families or 152 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Lahug Elementary School Gymnasium in Brgy. Lahug, Cebu City (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **30 families** or **171 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

There are 82 families or 323 persons still displaced in Brgy. Lahug, Cebu City (see Annex E).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 50 houses were damaged; of which, 44 are totally damaged and six (6) are partially damaged in Brgy. Lahug, Cebu City (see Annex F).

#### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱2,046,274.08 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱758,918.08 from DSWD and ₱1,287,356.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex G).
