

DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Mambaling, Cebu City

as of 16 March 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 02 March 2025 at around 1:18 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Mambaling, Cebu City. The fire was declared out at around 3:05 AM. A total of 1,076 individuals were affected by the incident, resulting in the destruction of 143 houses.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) through its Field Office (FO) VI, in close coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Cebu City, immediately provided food and non-food items (FNIs) to the affected individuals to support their immediate needs.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **182 families** or **1,076 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Mambaling, Cebu City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **168 families** or **686 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Viking Gymnasium** in **Brgy. Mambaling, Cebu City** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **14 families** or **390 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **182 families** or **1,076 persons** still displaced in **Brgy. Mambaling**, **Cebu City** (see Annex E).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **143 houses** were damaged; of which, **142** are **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Mambaling, Cebu City** (see Annex F).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱4,210.486.98 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱1,698,486.98 from DSWD and ₱2,512,000.00 from the LGU (see Annex G).
