

# DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Mantuyong, Mandaue City

as of 10 March 2025, 6AM

## I. Situation Overview

On 03 March 2025 at around 2:58 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Mantuyong, Mandaue City. The fire was declared out at around 4:42 PM.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office in Region VII, actively participated in the response operation and maintains continuous coordination with the Local Government Unit of Mandaue City to manage the needs of displaced families and individuals, provide timely updates, and address potential requests for relief augmentation.

A total of **157 families** or **568 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Mantuyong, Mandaue City** (see Annex A).

## **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **157 families** or **568 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Gymnasium** in **Brgy. Mantuyong, Mandaue City** (see Annex B).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **75 houses** were damaged; of which, **73** are totally damaged and two (2) are partially damaged in Brgy. Mantuyong, Mandaue City (see Annex C).
