

DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Paknaan, Mandaue City as of 14 April 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 23 March 2025 at around 7:34 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Paknaan, Mandaue City. The fire was declared out at around 10:32 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **271 families** or **1,007 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Paknaan, Mandaue City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **271 families** or **1,007 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **one (1) evacuation center** in **Brgy. Paknaan, Mandaue City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **180 houses** were damaged; of which, **173** are **totally damaged** and **seven (7)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Paknaan, Mandaue City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱2,130,000.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
