## I. Situation Overview

On 23 March 2025 at around 7:34 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Paknaan, Mandaue City. The fire was declared out at around 10:32 PM.

A total of **271 families** or **1,007 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Paknaan, Mandaue City** (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are 271 families or 1,007 persons currently taking temporary shelter in one (1) evacuation center in Brgy. Paknaan, Mandaue City (see Annex B).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 180 houses were damaged; of which, 173 are totally damaged and seven (7) are partially damaged in Brgy. Paknaan, Mandaue City (see Annex C).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P2,130,000.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
