

# DSWD DROMIC Report #5 on the Effects of Easterlies in Davao Region

as of 31 March 2025, 6PM

# I. Situation Overview

Issued on 17 March 2025 at 4:00 AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms were observed, attributed to the Easterlies. These conditions may have led to possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains affecting the Davao Region.

On the same day, continuous rainfall due to Easterlies caused flooding and landslides in the municipalities of Mabini, Davao de Oro and Malita, Davao Occidental.

In response to the incident, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) XI, promptly coordinated with the affected Local Government Units (LGUs) to gather significant updates and assess the need for resource augmentation to support the immediate relief efforts for the affected families.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **5,194 families** or **19,819 persons** are affected in **11 barangays** in **Davao Region** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **eight (8) families** or **29 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Tribal Building Old Barangay Hall** in **Davao Region** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **138 families** or **396 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

There are **146 families** or **425 persons** still displaced in **Davao Region** (see Annex D).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **15 houses** were damaged; of which, **10** are **totally damaged** and **five (5)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Napnapan, Pantukan, Davao de Oro** (see Annex E).



# V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱6,881,306.92** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱6,803,926.92** from **DSWD** and **₱77,380.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
