

DSWD DROMIC Report #6 on the Effects of Easterlies in Davao Region as of 01 April 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 17 March 2025 at 4:00 AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms were observed, attributed to the Easterlies. These conditions may have led to possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains affecting the Davao Region.

On the same day, continuous rainfall due to Easterlies caused flooding and landslides in the municipalities of Mabini, Davao de Oro and Malita, Davao Occidental.

In response to this incident, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office in Region XI, extended relief assistance comprising food and non-food items to address the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **5,287 families** or **20,034 persons** are affected in **12 barangays** in **Davao Region** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **eight (8) families** or **29 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Tribal Building Old Barangay Hall** in **Davao Region** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **190 families** or **529 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **198 families** or **558 persons** displaced in **Davao Region** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **15 houses** were damaged; of which, **10 are totally damaged** and **five (5) are partially damaged** in **Brgy. Napnapan, Pantukan, Davao de Oro** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱6,881,306.92** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of **₱6,803,926.92** from **DSWD** and **₱77,380.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
