

DSWD DROMIC Report #6 on the Effects of Easterlies in Davao de Oro

as of 12 March 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 25 February 2025 at 4:00 AM, cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms were observed, attributed to the Easterlies. These conditions may have led to possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains affecting the Davao Region.

On the same day, continuous rainfall due to Easterlies caused flooding and landslides in the municipalities of Nabunturan and New Bataan in Davao de Oro.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **9,598 families** or **48,214 persons** are affected in **33 barangays** in **Davao de Oro** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **797 families** or **3,299 persons** sought temporary shelter in **eight (8) evacuation centers** in **Davao de Oro** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **four (4) families** or **17 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are four (4) families or 17 persons still displaced in Davao de Oro (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of six (6) houses were damaged; of which, four (4) are totally damaged and two (2) are partially damaged in Davao de Oro (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P459,030.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
