

DSWD DROMIC Report #7 on the Effects of Easterlies in Davao Region as of 31 March 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 25 February 2025 at 4:00 AM, cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms were observed, attributed to the Easterlies. These conditions may have led to possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains affecting the Davao Region.

On the same day, continuous rainfall due to Easterlies caused flooding and landslides in the municipalities of Nabunturan and New Bataan in Davao de Oro.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **11,108 families** or **54,959 persons** are affected in **44 barangays** in **Davao Region** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **797 families** or **3,299 persons** sought temporary shelter in **eight (8) evacuation centers** in **Davao de Oro** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **487 families** or **2,386 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **1,284 families** or **5,685 persons** were displaced in **Davao de Region** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **six (6) houses** were damaged; of which, **four (4)** are **totally damaged** and **two (2)** are **partially damaged** in **Davao de Oro** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱834,120.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱673,530.00** from **DSWD**, and **₱160,590.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
