

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Agsaman, Jipapad, Eastern Samar

I. Situation Overview

On 18 March 2025, an ocular lockdown was enforced in Brgy. Agsaman, Jipapad, Eastern Samar. This measure was implemented by the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) under the 521B unit as part of their regular operations following an insurgency incident in a neighboring barangay.
