

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Panaytayan, Mansalay, Oriental Mindoro

19 May 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 01 March 2025 at around 10:15 AM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Lomboy, Brgy. Panaytayan, Mansalay, Oriental Mindoro between the Philippine Army's 4th Infantry Battalion and the members of the Communist Party of the Philippines-New People's Army (CPP-NPA) resulting in the displacement of 1,424 individuals in the area.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) MIMAROPA, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Mansalay, Oriental Mindoro, immediately provided relief assistance to the affected individuals to address their urgent needs.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **303 families** or **1,424 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Panaytayan, Mansalay, Oriental Mindoro** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **303 families** or **1,424 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Salay Elementary School** in **Brgy. Panaytayan, Mansalay, Oriental Mindoro** (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱345,389.70** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱269,639.70** from **DSWD** and **₱75,750.00** from the **LGU** (see Annex C).
