

# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Cabanglasan, Bukidnon

20 April 2025, 6PM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 04 March 2025, an armed conflict transpired between the 4th Infantry Division of the Philippine Army and members of the New People's Army in the mountains in Cabanglasan, Bukidnon. This incident raised concerns in surrounding areas, prompting authorities to alert residents in the affected communities and advise them to move to safer ground. To ensure public safety, residents were also prohibited from going to their farms due to military operations in the area.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **154 families** or **770 persons** were affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Cabanglasan, Bukidnon** (see Annex A).

### III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P245,788.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families, composed of **P95,788.00** from **DSWD** and **P150,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex B).
