

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Effects of Northeast Monsoon in Northern Luzon

02 May 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview


On 06 February 2025, cloudy skies with rains due to Northeast Monsoon may have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains over Cagayan Valley, Cordillera Administrative Region, Ilocos Norte, and Aurora. On the same day, several municipalities in Cagayan Valley experienced flooding due to the Northeast Monsoon.

On 08 February 2025 at around 4:00 PM, a strong wind incident due to the Northeast Monsoon was experienced in Brgy. Toboy, Asingan, Pangasinan.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **10,289 families** or **34,272 persons** were affected in **41 barangays** in **Regions I** and **II** (see Annex A).



III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **60 families** or **216 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).



IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Region I (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱9,909,508.19 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱9,898,908.19 from DSWD and ₱10,600.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
