

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 2 (Pob.), Bacolod City

29 March 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 09 March 2025 at around 8:00 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 2 (Pob.), Bacolod City. Due to the incident, 12 individuals were affected resulting in significant damages to their houses.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) through its Field Office (FO) VI, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Bacolod City, provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **three (3) families** or **12 persons** were affected in **Brgy. 2 (Pob.), Bacolod City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **three (3) families** or **12 persons** sought temporary shelter in **ABES 2** in **Brgy. 2 (Pob.), Bacolod City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of three (3) houses were damaged; of which, two (2) are totally damaged and one (1) is partially damaged in Brgy. 2 (Pob.), Bacolod City (see Annex D).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱31,860.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱18,990.00** from **DSWD**, and **₱12,870.00** from the **LGU** (see Annex E).
