

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Lahug, Cebu City

29 March 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 27 February 2025 at around 6:59 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Lahug, Cebu City. The fire was declared fire out at 9:41 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **82 families** or **323 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Lahug, Cebu City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **52 families** or **152 persons** sought temporary shelter **Lahug Elementary School Gymnasium** in **Brgy. Lahug, Cebu City** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **30 families** or **171 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **82 families** or **323 persons** were displaced in **Brgy. Lahug, Cebu City** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **50 houses** were damaged; of which, **44** are **totally damaged** and **six (6)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Lahug, Cebu City** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱2,152,415.09** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱812,059.09** from **DSWD**, **₱1,287,356.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)**, and **₱53,000.00** from **other Partners** (see Annex F).
