

## **DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Taculing, Bacolod City**

24 May 2025, 6PM

### **I. Situation Overview**

On 31 March 2025 at around 4:51 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Taculing, Bacolod City. Due to the incident, 16 individuals were affected and caused damage to their houses.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) VI, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Bacolod City, immediately provided food and non-food items (FNIs) to address the needs of the affected individuals.

### **II. Status of Affected Areas and Population**

A total of **four (4) families** or **16 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Taculing, Bacolod City** (see Annex A).

### **III. Status of Displaced Population**

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

A total of **four (4) families** or **16 persons** sought temporary shelter at **Multipurpose Hall** in **Brgy. Taculing, Bacolod City** (see Annex B).

### **IV. Damaged Houses**

A total of **four (4) houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Taculing, Bacolod City** (see Annex D).

### **V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided**

A total of **₱103,160.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱26,000.00** from **DSWD** and **₱77,160.00** from the **LGU** (see Annex E).
