

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Flash Flood Incident in Brgy. Caridad, Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat

24 May 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 07 May 2025 at 4:00 AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms, caused by prevailing Easterlies, may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms.

On the same day, a flash flood incident was experienced in Brgy. Caridad, Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat due to moderate to heavy rains brought by the Easterlies.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) XII, in close coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat, immediately provided relief assistance to address the needs of the 2,435 affected individuals.

A total of **487 families** or **2,435 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Caridad, Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat** (see Annex A).
