

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Flooding Incident in Maguindanao del Sur

26 May 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 28 February 2025 at 4:00 PM, cloudy skies with scattered rains and isolated thunderstorms caused by Shear Line may have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains in Mindanao, Eastern and Central Visayas.

On the same day, a flooding incident occurred in some municipalities in Maguindanao del Sur due to Shear Line.

A total of **22,601 families** or **67,803 persons** were affected in **35 barangays** in **Maguindanao del Sur** (see Table 1).
