

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Sagrada, Iriga City, Camarines Sur as of 19 April 2025, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 18 April 2025 at around 6 AM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Montañosa Brgy. Sagrada, Iriga City, Camarines Sur between the Philippine Army and members of the Communist Party of the Philippines - New People's Army (CPP-NPA). Several residents in the area were deeply affected and left traumatized by the conflict.

A total of **65 families** or **281 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Sagrada, Iriga City, Camarines Sur** (see Annex A).
