

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Tapi, City of Kabankalan, Negros Occidental

as of 28 April 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 27 April 2025 at around 5:30 AM, an encounter happened between the elements of 47th, 15th and 11th Infantry Batallions under the 302nd Infantry Brigade of the Philippine Army and alleged members of the Communist Party of the Philippines-New People's Army (CPP-NPA) in the hinterland part of Purok Maghirupay, Brgy. Tapi, City of Kabankalan, Negros Occidental. Seven (7) alleged communist members were killed in the encounter that also resulted in one (1) house totally damaged.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **180 families** or **900 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Tapi, City of Kabankalan, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **180 families** or **900 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Tapi, City of Kabankalan, Negros Occidental (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱129,900.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** to the affected families (see Annex D).
