

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Kabugao, Apayao as of 16 April 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 05 April to 11 April 2025, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Maragat and Brgy. Dagara in Kabugao, Apayao between the Philippine Army's 98th Infantry (MASINAG) Battalion and the members of the Communist Terrorists Group (CTG) resulting in the displacement of families and individuals in the area.

A total of **335 families** or **1,330 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Kabugao, Apayao** (see Table 1).
