

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of African Swine Fever in Bohol

as of 12 April 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 15 January 2025, an outbreak of African Swine Fever (ASF) was reported in the municipality of Danao, Bohol. Affected families experienced substantial financial losses due to the culling of infected animals and severely disrupting local hog production.

On 7 March 2025, the Municipality of Buenavista detected ASF in Barangay Bantuan. Given the highly contagious nature of ASF among domestic and wild pigs, they imposed a lockdown to contain the disease. The ASF outbreak has continued to spread, the municipalities of Buenavista, Carmen, Pilar, San Miguel, Trinidad and Ubay have also reported ASF cases and sought financial assistance from SWAD Bohol to support affected hog raisers.

ASF is a highly contagious viral disease of domestic and wild pigs, whose mortality rate can reach 100%. It is not a danger to human health, but it has devastating effects on pig populations and the farming economy. The virus is highly resistant to the environment, meaning that it can survive on clothes, boots, wheels, and other materials.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 2,352 persons are affected in 61 barangays in Bohol (see Annex A).

III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}4,231,676.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected persons; of which, \$\mathbb{P}4,221,676.00\$ from \$\mathbb{DSWD}\$ and \$\mathbb{P}10,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex B).
