

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of Easterlies in Dipolog City, Zamboanga del Norte as of 16 April 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 15 April 2025 at 4:00 AM, cloudy skies with scattered rains and thunderstorms caused by Easterlies may have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains in Zamboanga Peninsula, Basilan, Sulu, and Tawi-Tawi.

On the same day, continuous rainfall brought by Easterlies led to flooding and landslides in several barangays in Dipolog City, Zamboanga del Norte.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) through its Field Office (FO) IX, in close coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Dipolog City, promptly provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families.

A total of **335 families** or **1,675 persons** are affected in **three (3) barangays** in **Dipolog City, Zamboanga del Norte** (see Annex A).
