

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) in Maitum, Sarangani

as of 10 April 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 06 April 2025 at 4:00 AM, Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting Davao Region, SOCCSKSARGEN, BARMM, Zamboanga Peninsula, and Palawan. Cloudy skies with scattered rains and thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains.

On the same day, several barangays in Maitum, Sarangani experienced flash flood due to heavy rains brought by the ITCZ.

Further, a strong wind incident was also reported in another barangay caused by the same weather disturbance.
