

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of Northeast Monsoon in Medellin, Cebu as of 12 April 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

From January to February 2025, the Province of Cebu was affected by the effects of the Northeast Monsoon, locally known as “Amihan”.

On 25 February 2025, all motorbanca operations were suspended in the municipality of Medellin, Cebu due to the effects of the Northeast Monsoon affecting the livelihood of the fisherfolk living in coastal barangays of the municipalities.
