

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 1 (Pob.), San Carlos City, Negros Occidental

as of 04 April 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 15 March 2025 at around 3:00 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 1 (Pob.), San Carlos City, Negros Occidental.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **26 families** or **108 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 1 (Pob.), San Carlos City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 21 families or 89 persons currently taking temporary shelter in Covered Court in Brgy. 1 (Pob.), San Carlos City, Negros Occidental (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are three (3) families or 12 persons temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex E).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are 24 families or 101 persons still displaced in Brgy. 1 (Pob.), San Carlos City, Negros Occidental (see Annex F).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 26 houses were damaged; of which, 25 are totally damaged and One (1) are partially damaged in Brgy. 1 (Pob.), San Carlos City, Negros Occidental (see Annex G).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P463,154.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **P218,920.00** from **DSWD** and **P53,914.00** from the **Local Government Unit** (**LGU**) (see Annex H).
