

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 118, Tondo, Manila City

as of 26 April 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 23 April 2025 at around 1:57 AM, a fire incident occurred at Rawis St., Brgy. 118, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared under control at 7:09 AM. No casualties were reported during the incident.

There are 130 families or 420 persons currently taking temporary shelter along Rawis Street in Brgy. 118, Tondo, Manila City (see Annex B).
