

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 118, Tondo, Manila City as of 26 April 2025, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 23 April 2025 at around 1:57 AM, a fire incident occurred at Rawis St., Brgy. 118, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared under control at 7:09 AM. No casualties were reported during the incident.

A total of **130 families** or **420 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 118, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex A).

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **130 families** or **420 persons** currently taking temporary shelter along **Rawis Street** in **Brgy. 118, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **50 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 118, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex C).
