

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 123, Tondo, Manila City

as of 24 April 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 23 April 2025 at around 1:56 AM, a fire incident occurred at Road 10, Moriones St., Brgy 123, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 7:09 AM. Due to the incident, 2,225 individuals were affected, resulting in significant damages to their houses.

As part of the response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) National Capital Region (NCR), immediately conducted Rapid Disaster Assessment and Needs Analysis (RDANA) to assess the needs and situations of the affected individuals for timely and appropriate interventions.

A total of **445 families** or **2,225 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 123, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex A).

There are 445 families or 2,225 persons currently taking temporary shelter in Moriones Street in Brgy. 123, Tondo, Manila City (see Annex B).
