

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 7, Pasay City

as of 21 April 2025, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 16 April 2025 at around 11:25 PM, a fire incident occurred at San Juan St., Brgy. 7, Pasay City. The fire was declared out at around 12:53 AM the following day resulting in damages to properties and displacement of 212 individuals.

At present, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) National Capital Region (NCR), is closely coordinating with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Pasay City for any request for relief assistance to address the urgent needs of the affected individuals.

A total of **53 families** or **212 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 7, Pasay City** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **53 families or 212 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at **Andres Bonifacio Elementary School** in **Brgy. 7, Pasay City** (see Annex B).

A total of five (5) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. 7, Pasay City (see Annex C).
