

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Azucena, Tagana-an, Surigao del Norte

as of 25 April 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 13 April 2025 at around 9:00 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Azucena, Tagana-an, Surigao del Norte. The fire was declared out at around 11:39 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **four (4) families** or **21 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Azucena, Tagana-an, Surigao del Norte** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **two (2) families** or **14 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in the **Senior Citizen Federated Building** in **Brgy. Azucena, Tagana-an, Surigao del Norte** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **two (2) houses** were **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Azucena, Tagana-an, Surigao del Norte** (see Annex D).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱87,726.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱42,726.00** from **DSWD** and **₱45,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex E).
