

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Balulang, Cagayan de Oro City

#### I. Situation Overview

On 26 March 2025 at around 11:29 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Balulang, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 12:33 PM.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **14 families** or **55 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Balulang**, **Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **14 families** or **55 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy**. **Balulang Outpost** in **Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex B).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 14 houses were damaged; of which, 12 are totally damaged and two (2) are partially damaged in Brgy. Balulang, Cagayan de Oro City(see Annex C).

#### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P161,910.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **P124,544.00** from **DSWD** and **P37,366.00** from the **Local Government Unit** (**LGU**) (see Annex D).
