

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Balulang, Cagayan de Oro City as of 24 April 2025, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 26 March 2025 at around 11:29 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Balulang, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 12:33 PM.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **14 families** or **55 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Balulang, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **14 families** or **55 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Balulang Outpost** in **Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **14 houses** were damaged; of which, **12** are **totally damaged** and **two (2)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Balulang, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱161,910.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱124,544.00** from **DSWD** and **₱37,366.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
