

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Barangka Itaas, Mandaluyong City

as of 22 April 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 April 2025 at around 4:18 AM, a fire incident occurred at Makaturing St., Brgy. Barangka Itaas, Mandaluyong City. The fire was declared out at around 4:46 AM. Due to the incident, 40 individuals were affected, significantly damaging their houses.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) National Capital Region (NCR), immediately provided relief assistance to address the urgent needs of the affected individuals.

A total of **10 families** or **40 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Barangka Itaas**, **Mandaluyong City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **10 families** or **40 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Barangka Itaas Brgy. Hall** in **Mandaluyong City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **10 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Barangka Itaas Brgy. Hall** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱48,242.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
