

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Basak Pardo, Cebu City

as of 19 April 2025, 6AM

## I. Situation Overview

On 18 April 2025 at around 9:49 AM, a fire incident occurred at Fort San Pedro, Brgy. Veterans Village, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 11:27 AM. Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) VII

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **73 families** or **261 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Basak Pardo, Cebu City** (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **73 families** or **261 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Basak Community School** in **Brgy. Basak Pardo, Cebu City** (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **46 houses** were damaged; of which, **44** are **totally damaged** and **two (2)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Basak Pardo**, **Cebu City** (see Annex C).
