I. Situation Overview

On 14 April 2025 at around 9:12 PM, a fire incident occurred at Rosero St., Brgy. Centro, City of Masbate. The fire was declared out at around 11:30 PM.

A total of **41 families** or **64 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Centro**, **City of Masbate** (see Annex A).

A total of three (3) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Centro, City of Masbate (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P187,603.22** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families(see Annex C).
